Following is the pertinent information for this year's tournament:

When: **May 15 and 16, 2010**

Where: **John Blanche Memorial Soccer Complex, Temecula, CA**

Who: **Boys and Girls**  
**AREA 11-L SPRING TEAMS ONLY – U10, U12, U14, U16 and U19**  
**(up to 3 guest players allowed, must be registered Fall 09)**

Qualifications: AYSO Registered players only.  
The birth date defining maximum player age will be July 31, 2009.

Flighting: Based on number of entries – in correlation with Spring seeding, wherever possible.

Entry Fees: **\$325.00 per team.** This fee must accompany the entry form.

**\$175.00 Referee Deposit.** This fee will be completely refunded if a qualified 3-person referee team officiates a **MINIMUM** of THREE (3) games on behalf of your team. No partial refunds. **Preference will be given to those teams providing referees.**

Refund Policy: A full refund will be issued if the tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws from the tournament 30 days or more prior to the tournament, a full refund is given. If less than 30 days, no refund will be issued unless a replacement team is found.

Awards: All players and two (2) coaches per team in the tournament will receive a tournament pin.  
Coaches – two (2) per team will receive a tournament T-shirt.  
Medals awarded to teams finishing 1 – 4 in each flight.  
Championship teams will receive Championship T-shirts.

Referees will receive a tournament T-shirt, tournament pin and coin.

Payment: Please remit **one (1) check in the amount of \$500.00 per team**, payable to **AYSO Area 11-L** and mail with application and team roster, signed by the RC.
