U10 COACH TRAINING

<u>What:</u> AYSO training course that qualifies individuals to earn their U10 Coach certificate upon

completion. This is a necessary course for anyone that will be coaching a U10 team

regardless of any other training they may have received in or out of AYSO.

Requirements: In order to receive credit for the course, candidates must meet the following criteria:

Be a registered volunteer as documented in eAYSO

• Be present for all roll calls. 100% attendance is required

When: Saturday, 8:15 AM (sign-in) – 12:30 PM (lunch will be provided)

Where: Laguna Hills High School. Park and enter as indicated on the map link. Look for signs

leading you to the check-in table. From there you will be directed to a class room.

Bring: Pen or pencil, pad, soccer ball, hat, sunscreen, towel, and extra shirt. Appropriate

clothing and footwear to allow participation in field sessions is recommended.

Registration: Is available online here. Fill out and submit the form, then follow the instructions given on

the confirmation page. Registrations submitted after <u>January 20th</u>, <u>2017</u> may be placed on a wait list and accepted on a space-available basis. No shows and cancellations after that date by attendees from outside of Area 11-L will lose their fee. No shows and

cancellations after that date by attendees from within Area 11-L will have their fee billed

to their region.

Payment: If you are registered as a volunteer from one of the regions listed on the 11L Regions

page of www.ayso11L.org then you do not need to pay; your region will be billed.

Applicants from outside of Area 11-L must include the course fee of \$45, (region check, money order, or prepaid online only), paid in advance, in order to reserve a seat in this class. This payment must be made in advance, your region will not be billed nor do we accept promise of payment by your region. Please do not bring payment to class. Mail it in or pay online in advance. Contact your region for their reimbursement policy.

All applications must be postmarked by January 20th, 2017. Later submissions may be placed on a wait list.

Only the first 30 completed applications will be accepted.
